



Firework Patterns

- You can use any size paper globe lantern for this project.
- Open the lantern the day before you plan to work so it holds its shape better and the paper has a chance to stretch out into the globe shape.
- Fill the lantern with crumpled newspaper so that it stays open as you work.
- If you want the lanterns to look just like ours, transfer the patterns using carbon tracing paper and then draw over the traced lines with a fine- or medium-tipped colored marker. But we recommend thinking of these patterns as inspiration for freehand drawing firework bursts on the lanterns with a pencil then tracing with the colored marker. Take it slow, use your imagination, and don't worry if you "mess up." After all, no two fireworks are alike!
